This Indenture made this Eighth Day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty, Two, Between William Roane of the Parish of South Farnham, the County of Esex, and State of Virginia Gentleman of the one Part and Spencer Reane, of the said Parish, County, and State, Son of the said William of the other Part, Witnefseth that the said William as well for and in Consideration of the Natural Love and affection which he hath and beareth unto the said Spencer as also for the better Maintenance and Preferment of the said Spencer, Hath given granted, aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these Presents doth give, grant, alien enjeof and

confirm unto the said Spencer all the Negro Slaves following to with Frank, Patt, and her children, nan, Gloster, Jude, both, Ben; alice and her Children, Will, Luce Rove, Bett; Hannah, Richard, & yorah regether with their future Increase, and all other Emoluments to them belonging, or any of them, or in any wise appertaining; and all the State Right Fatle, Interest Property, Claim, or Domand, whatsoever frim the vaid Wellearn of in, and to every and all the above mente med Slaves; and all Deeds, Evidences and Writings concerning the same Slaves only now in the Hands of the said Hilliam or which he may get, or come by without Suit in San; To have and to hold the said Slaves, together with their future Increase to the said Spencer his Heirs & apigns forever, and the vaid William for himself his heirs . Executors & administrators, doth bovenant and grant to and with the vaid Spencer his heirs & assigns by these Presents, that he the said Spencer his heirs and apigns shall and lawfully may from henceforth forever hereafter peaceably and quelly, have hold, occupy possess and enjoy the said Slaves and their Increase free, clear, and discharged from all former and other Gifts, Grants, Bargains, and Sales, Freoffments, Sointwes Dowers States Judgments & all other Titles, and Incumbrances whatvoever had, made committed, or done, or to be had, made, committed, or done by him the said William his heirs, Executors, or administrators or any other Person, or Persons lanfully claiming or to claim by, from, or under, him them, or any, or either of them. In Mitness whereof the Party first above named to this Indenture has Subscribed his hame and affixed his Seal the Day and year first above written Sealed and delivered in the Presence of Roane Eval Henry Clements Rathh Mitchell
